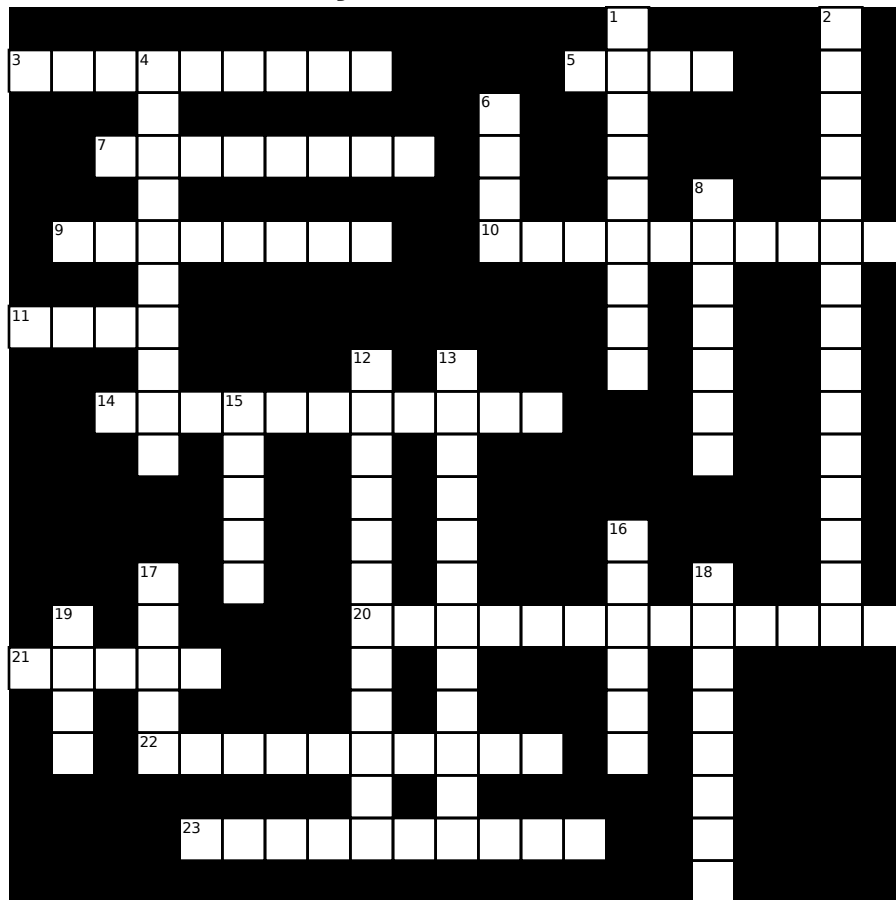


# Literary Terms Crossword Puzzle

- 14 main character or good guy
